Marpan Recycling hosts grand opening today

Marpan Recycling will have its official grand opening and ribbon cutting today to introduce a new recovery facility that will handle construction and demolition debris, yard waste and other materials.

Owner Kim Williams says the facility has been designed to make hauling and dumping quicker, easier, and less expensive than existing options. For those seeking a "green" alternative to landfill disposal, Marpan estimates that 70 percent of all materials received will be sorted and recycled.

Marpan Recycling is on Woodville Highway south of Capital Circle.

"We are excited to finally be able to bring a world-class recycling facility to Leon County," Williams said. "Now everyone from professional haulers to residents in our region will have a sensible and green option for handling construction and demolition debris and yard waste."
